 Also, I can turn my head 270 degrees*

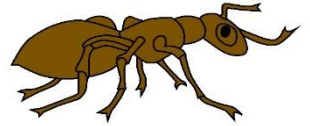
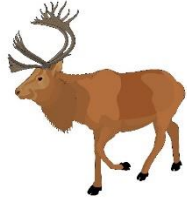

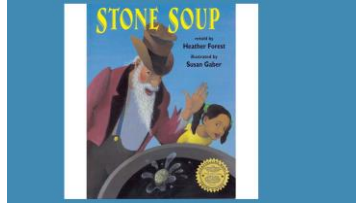

They knocked on a door, and when it was opened, a woman asked: What do you want? One of the travelers answered: We are hungry, do you have any food? The woman said: no and closed the door.



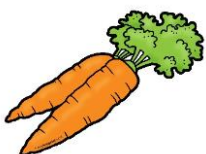
The travelers knocked on more and more doors and the answer always was the same I don't care, I won't share, there's no food here. Nobody wanted to help them.
